DP Student of the Year and Spirit Awards: Do we want to allow students to apply for both or only one category? Overwhelming support to allow students to apply for both categories 4. Report from IB World Conference: Randy Hiatt. Randy supplied all the session ppts and materials that he received to be shared out in a google drive folder.
