1. In-State University contacts for IB Transcripts/Exams	Discussion regarding ASU process in their registration office to access IB exam scores per Jennifer Morgan at ASU. It seems that there is a process and person in the ASU Registrar office that downloads the IB Transcripts from the IB website. Menton gave ASU contact email if coordinators run into problems over the summer – <u>courses@asu.edu</u> They would be happy to assist. IB score access could be delayed if : discrepancies/differences in names, date of birth discrepancies or the student has not yet applied to ASU.	
2. AZIBS Scholarship Reminder	Reminder to all IB coordinators to please encourage and advertise the AZIBS student scholarship to your students and nominate an IB teacher at your school for the AZIBS IB Teacher of the Year award.	
3. New IB Graduate Survey posted on AZIBS	Menton shared that the IB Graduate Data is posted on the AZIBS website. 16 IB high schools participated and were acknowledged on the AZIBS website. Thank you to Anne Bender who took the data and made the form colorful and beautiful. This fall, we will send out another google doc survey form to all the IB high schools for the May 2016 candidates.	
4. AP Capstone Program and AP Capstone Diploma	Discussion about the new AP Capstone Program, AP's answer to IB. Cactus Shadows may be offering this in addition to IB Program which could be a challenge. No other IB schools are offering this program at this time. Discussion on how to be able to allow IB students to be able to allow IB students to receive an AP certificate as well, since many IB students take multiple AP exams in addition to IB exams.	

5. Alg 2/Math Studies/AZ Merit	Scott shared that in some schools the concepts for Alg 2 are not covered by the end of junior year, but they are still being AZmerit tested. Would like to look into testing after senior year when all of the content has been covered. Would like to reach out to the state for discussion of this.
